


Careers this week

Subject in the Spotlight– History



All year groups are receiving feedback on their end of year assessments and completing their final units of the year.

Year 7: Y7 are finishing off their last unit of the year on the Renaissance, they have explored Renaissance art, medicine and inventions. Which will help prepare them to move onto learning about the Tudor 'Religious

rollercoaster' when we return in September!

Year 8: Y8 have been learning about the British Empire and the Industrial Revolution, looking at the impact of colonialism on Canada, Australia, Africa and India, and how Britain began moving towards modernity. We will pick up from here when we return in Y9!

Year 9: Y9 have been learning about the creation of the modern world, and Post-War Britain, including immigration, Windrush, the Cold War, the NHS and the changing role of women. This has been a great opportunity for students to consolidate the key themes they have studied throughout KS3 and prepare those going on to study History at GCSE for the start of their course!

Year 10: Y10 students are coming to the end of their second GCSE unit on the topic on 'Elizabethan England'. In the final lessons of the year we will finish looking at our 'Historic environment study' on Hardwick Hall and respond to feedback from the mock exams. This will mark the half way point in their GCSE course, as we will have finished the second of their four units by the end of the week. Well done for all your hard work so far this year Y10.
