Grammar Stream STEM Day

Last week, 65 students from the Year 7 and Year 8 Grammar Stream took part in an exciting full-day STEM workshop run by the Smallpeice Trust. The day challenged students to step into the shoes of real engineers and entrepreneurs as they worked in teams to design, build, and market their own motorised boats. Each group began by brainstorming ideas and sketching designs before moving on to construct working prototypes using foam, which they then tested in a water tank. Students used their problem-solving skills to refine and improve their designs, before creating their final products using wood.

But the challenge didn't stop at engineering! Teams also had to manage their finances, plan a marketing strategy, and finally present their finished product to the group. The activity encouraged creativity, teamwork, and innovation which are key skills for success in STEM and beyond. The workshop was filled with energy and enthusiasm, with students fully engaged throughout the day. There were plenty of moments of triumph (and a few splashes!) as the boats were finally put to the test.

By the end of the day, students had not only gained hands-on experience in engineering and design but also developed important skills in communication, planning, and perseverance. The Smallpeice Trust facilitators praised the students for their enthusiasm, ingenuity, and teamwork. It was a fantastic opportunity for our Grammar Stream students to experience the excitement of STEM in action and the students thoroughly enjoyed the day.
