We start the year with an immense sense of pride at yet another record breaking year for results. I spent my summer counting down to results day because I knew our pupils had done well, but wow I was honestly blown away when I woke up on that Thursday morning. It gives me such pride to announce that our headline figures are 93% 4+ and 88%

5+, putting us top of the United Learning league table. I am particularly pleased to announce that 48%, nearly 1/2, of all of our grades in maths and English this summer were a 7+.
