Tree planting in Hurlingham Park

On the bright and sunny Wednesday morning, Y7 pupils were offered the chance to plant their very own tree saplings at our local open space, Hurlingham Park. As part of our pledge to improve sustainability and help our ecosystem, pupils were determined at bettering the park and will also look ahead to maintaining these plants in the coming months and years.

Pupils were shown how to arrange, dig, and plant their saplings, which will grow into wonderful expansive plants and trees. In their pairs, one pupil would dig a number of holes for planting, while their partner placed their sapling in and covered the sapling with the soil. They would then swap roles and each have a go at the entire process of planting. We spent over an hour to get through the entire stock of saplings, which means that our pupils planted over 400 in the hour!
