Welcome to Lambeth Academy Sixth Form






VESPA supported by Habits

Our Way of Teaching You

Lambeth Academy Sixth Form is a place where students' learning comes first. We know that there are many facets to learning, and not all learning happens within a classroom, but we also know that the grades you achieve at the end of Year 13 play the biggest part in your chance to get into **the best universities.**

That's why at Lambeth Academy, we insist on **quality-first teaching**. Students in the Sixth Form get the same deal in lessons as every other student across the school. Lessons are based around the idea of moving you, as learners, from dependence upon the teacher for the knowledge you need to be successful, to complete independence in your ability and skill level. We make sure that every lesson chunks the new learning into manageable pieces, with an opportunity for you to learn new knowledge, practice using it with your teacher and peers, and then use it independently.

We are also very proud of the teachers we choose to teach Sixth Form lessons. Teaching Year 12 and 13 at Lambeth Academy is a privilege. All of our teachers are expected to be **experts in their field**. They know their subject inside out, they know your areas of strength and areas that need development, and they know how to teach their subject.

We take the care of students very seriously and engage with **Student Voice** and offer wellbeing and mental health support. Our tutor programme is designed to develop student's ability to make 'healthy, wise and principled choices' and to 'make a positive contribution to global society' by embedding public speaking and debating skills, as well as incorporating current affairs into sessions each week.

Our Academic Offer


We were very proud of the fantastic achievements of last year's Year 13. Two of our subjects performed in the top 1% of schools across the country, three performed in the top 10% and another four performed in the top quarter of schools nationally.

We are confident in our approach and in our academic offer to you.

This includes a **diverse range** of A Level qualifications such as Maths, Further Maths, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, English Literature, Psychology, Sociology, Physical Education, History, Geography, Philosophy & Ethics, Drama, French, Spanish, Mandarin and Music.

Additionally, we also offer BTEC courses in Business, Sport and Health & Social Care. We are also **proud to offer the Extended Project Qualification** and **supercurricular provision** for each subject.

Our offer is flexible year on year, based on the demand for subjects from you and on the expertise of our teachers.



Enrichment and Careers

We know that enrichment and careers opportunities are essential for students to reach their goals. They are an intrinsic part of our offer because we know that they are essential for the development of, **high self-esteem and confidence**, as well as employability skills and exposure to different career paths.

Our approach to our enrichment and careers provision is guided by our values of 'Honourable Leadership', 'Commitment to Progress' and 'Excellence in Thinking'. Proud to offer a **wide-range** of A-Level, Pre-U and BTEC courses


