Debate Mate Cup – Y10

On Wednesday 23rd April, twelve Y10 pupils took part in the Debate Mate Cup hosted at UCL. The competition comprised of three debates; one seen and prepared, and two unseen motions covering topics such as government, sustainability, celebrities, and public sector workers. The pupils have trained with Debate Mate since November, and the progress that they have made with formal debating has been exceptional, competing against some schools that have training on this course for more than three years. We won four out of our six debates against other schools across London, and finished 10th and 11th out of a total of 30 competing schools. We were also present for a careers talk from two undergraduate students at UCL who study architecture, which was incredibly beneficial for our pupils to find out more about different university courses and university life! It has been great seeing the pupils improve over the past five months, and this will be fantastic preparation for work experience, and interviews in the future. Well done, team!

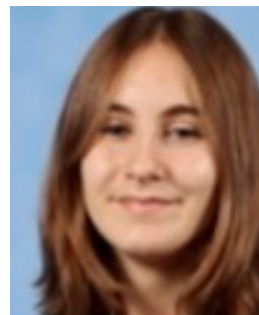
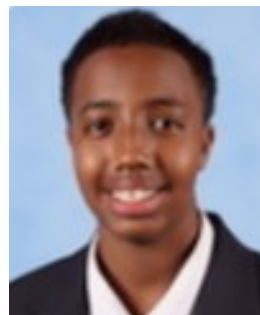


