Therefore, as part of our transition programme, every family is invited to an interview with the Transition Leaders and the Senior Staff of our school. Meetings will be scheduled for approximately 10-15 minutes. <u>There will be no allocated</u> time slots and you are welcome to attend anytime between 4:00-6:00pm.

This interview will provide your child and you with an opportunity to talk about your child's interests, needs and how best we can support them at The Hurlingham Academy. It will also give you the chance to ask any questions you might have about our school. Additionally, we request all students to bring a piece of school work that they are most proud of to talk about at the interview.

Induction Day – Friday 21st June 2024

This is for all Year 6 students joining us in September 2024. Students should report to The Hurlingham Academy at 9:00am. Senior Staff and transition leaders will be present to greet your child at the entrance gate and in the playground. Students should wear their primary school uniform, if they have one; if not, they should be dressed smartly. They should also wear their sport shoes for the PE activities on the day. Students will then have a day of taster lessons and experience some secondary school learning. They will be given snacks at break as well as a free lunch. The day finishes at 3:00pm when parents may collect their child from The Hurlingham Academy playground. If your child is being taken home by an older brother or sister already at the academy, we will supervise them in the academy library until 3:30pm, but you must inform us in the morning during the am registration.

We are aware of the vital ongoing role you play in supporting your child and we are sure you will be interested in hearing how we feel we can work together to support them.
