## What is a **Knowledge Organiser**?


A Knowledge Organiser is a list of key facts and vocabulary that it is critical for you to memorise. For each subject, the knowledge organisers in this booklet will help you to access, revise and enjoy your lessons at The Hurlingham Academy.

Part of your homework will be to learn this knowledge in small sections. You will be quizzed on this knowledge by your teacher in your lessons. You must achieve 80% in a Knowledge Quiz to pass.

## How can I use my Knowledge Organisers to help memorisation?

- 1. Read a section of your knowledge organiser
- 2. Cover it up
- 3. Write out what you've remembered
- 4. Check the knowledge organiser to see if you are correct
- 5. Repeat this process

Revise your knowledge organiser every day to help store the information in your long-term memory.
