23	Piano	<i>p</i>	Soft
24	Mezzo piano	<i>mp</i>	Moderately soft
25	Mezzo forte	<i>mf</i>	Moderately loud
26	Forte	<i>f</i>	Loud
27	Fortissimo	<i>ff</i>	Very loud
28	Crescendo		Gradually louder
29	Diminuendo		Gradually softer
