RE: Reward Trip to Thorpe Park, Thursday May 21st

We are delighted to inform you that your child is eligible to attend the trip to Thorpe Park on **Thursday May 21st**. This trip is given to those students who achieved more than 96%, 30 or more merits, less than 2 homework detentions and less than 4 demerits from 2February 23rd. Students will only need to pay £30 towards the ticket to Thorpe Park **via your child's account on Parent pay**

Your child needs to arrive at a normal time on the day of the trip. They are allowed to wear their own clothes and to take their own bags on the trip. We will travel by coach; therefore we need students to arrive on time so that we leave promptly. We will leave Thorpe Park at 4:30pm, aiming to be back in school by 6pm.

Students can bring a packed lunch with them. At Thorpe Park there is also a variety of restaurants and food snack stores for students to buy a meal if they wish to do so. We highly recommend students bring plenty of water or refreshments as they can be very costly at the theme park.

As your child is representing The Hurlingham Academy, your child must wear comfortable and appropriate clothing. We will expect your child to be on their best behavior. We would appreciate it if you could, please, reinforce with your child the importance of listening and following teachers' instructions at all times.

If you would like your child to attend the trip, please make payment by **Thursday April 30th**. **Please note that this trip is run on a first-come, first-served basis with a limited number of students being able to go. The cost of the trip must be paid before Thursday July 10th to guarantee your child's place. If you have concerns about payment, please contact me.**

Please note that your child will still be eligible to attend the trip as long as he/she maintains the same expectations of attendance and behavior given until now. If expectations drop, your child will not attend this reward trip.
